<u>Assignment</u>: Using the readings and a bit of outside research as evidence if needed, write a brief one-page (front and back maximum) paper on this topic:

TASK: Develop an argument that discusses whether the United States has a democracy.

Questions to consider: What is democracy? Who has the power in a democracy? Who leads in a democracy?

Evidence – use at least two pieces of evidence from the reading(s) to	4 pts
support your thesis or claim	
Reasoning – explain why each piece of evidence links to the thesis or claim	2 pts
Citation – provide a works cited and in-text/footnotes in either MLA or	1 pt
Chicago format
