

Gill St. Bernard's Summer 2021 – Health and Safety Protocols

Gill St. Bernard's has had a very successful year of in-person learning on campus. To continue to maintain the safety of our students, campers, faculty, and staff, we are enforcing the following protocols.

PCR Testing:

- Those who are not vaccinated will be required to submit a negative PCR test within 72 hours of the start of their program.
- Those who are fully vaccinated and have completed the 14-day period since their final dose will not have to submit a PCR test. They will be required to provide proof of vaccination.

Health Screenings:

- Parents/Guardians are asked to monitor their child/children for any signs of illness prior to leaving the home.
- Upon arriving on campus individuals will be asked a short list of health questions followed by a temperature reading of the forehead or wrist.

Mask Policy:

Indoor settings

- While in the Cox building all individuals will be required to wear masks. This is the primary location for PreK through grades 6 who are currently unable to receive the vaccination.
- In all other buildings, those who are vaccinated are not required to wear masks.
- Unvaccinated individuals are encouraged to wear masks indoors when physical distancing is difficult.

Outdoor settings

- Regardless of their vaccination status individuals are not required to wear a mask.
- Unvaccinated individuals are encouraged to wear a mask in crowded settings where activities may involve sustained close contact with people who are not fully vaccinated.

Social Distancing and Prevention Measures:

- All classrooms and teaching areas will be set up at a minimum spacing of three feet for social distancing.
- Handwash and hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the campus both indoors and outdoors.
- Best practices will be used in cleaning and sanitizing the buildings, equipment, and busses.
